Apprenticeships at Southport Colle

Hospitality Supervisor (Level 3)

This apprenticeship develops the knowledge, skills and behaviours required for a Food and Beverage Supervisor.

Why study this course?

- Gain experience/formal qualifications and earn why you learn!
- → Learn how to be a Supervisor in a Food and Beverage environment.
- If you already work as a Supervisor in the industry we help you gain formal qualifications

Who is the course aimed at?

This course is aimed at experienced Food and Beverage Assistants who are ready to take the next step as a Supervisor.

What will you study?

- → All practical and theoretical aspects of Food and Beverage Supervision.
- → Level 2 Functional Skills if required.

Behaviours you will develop

Working as a Hospitality Supervisor requires good communication skills, customer service and an understanding of the Hospitality environment, all of which are covered by this qualification.

Entry requirements

- You will need to complete initial assessments in Maths and English and take part in an interview with a member of our Assessment Team.
- You will need to be working in an environment that will provide you with the opportunities to learn and develop Hospitality Supervision skills.

How long will it last?

→ 13 - 18 months

How will it be delivered

- → At Southport College we like to treat all out Hospitality Apprentices as individuals and work around the needs of the Employer and Apprentice. The main body of the Apprenticeship is delivered in your workplace on a one-to-one basis with your Employer/Assessor and Southport College Facilitate Weekly sessions in the College for further Practical Delivery. This will be assessed through the completion of a portfolio of evidence and an External End Point Assessment.
- → Maths and English development will be delivered in the Classroom at Southport College on a flexible basis to suit the Apprentice and employer. If you have a Grade C or 4 in GCSE you will be exempt from Maths and English.
- → You and your employer must demonstrate a commitment to off the job training to support completion of this apprenticeship

Qualifications gained

- → Level 3 Food and Beverage Supervisor
- → Level 2 Functional skills Maths and English (if required)

Progression to further study

Advanced Apprentices, with support and opportunities in the workplace, can progress onto careers as Food and Beverage Managers or a wide range of other Hospitality Supervisor roles.
