- Maths and English development will be delivered through a mixture of College based sessions and assignments in the workplace, if needed
- → Employment Rights and Responsibilities will be embedded into the NVQ delivery

Qualifications gained

- Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Trowel Occupations
- → Level 2 Diploma in Bricklaying
- → L1 Maths and English

Progression to further study

After gaining work experience there are also opportunities to progress into occupational work supervision, management or technical support areas
