Knowledge and skills you will develop

- Learning different aspects of building
- Estimating materials and pricing jobs
- Building skills

Behaviours you will develop

- Communications between various members of the team and clients

Entry requirements

- You will need to complete initial assessments in maths and English and take part in an interview with a member of our Assessment Team
- You will need to be working in an environment that will provide you with the opportunities to learn and develop your construction skills

How long will it last?

- 30 months

How will it be delivered

- You will attend college one day per week and be assessed in the workplace
- Maths and English development will be delivered through a mixture of College based sessions and assignments in the workplace, if needed
- Employment Rights and Responsibilities will be embedded into the NVQ delivery

Qualifications gained

- Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Trowel Occupations
- Level 2 Diploma in Bricklaying
- L1 Maths and English

Progression to further study

- After gaining work experience there are also opportunities to progress into occupational work supervision, management or technical support areas
