Who is the course aimed at?

This course is aimed at learners that are looking to start a career in the construction industry as a bricklayer.

Learners can progress through the Apprenticeship route towards becoming a master craftsman.

What will you study?

Level 2 Functional Skills in Maths and English (exemptions apply)

Knowledge and skills that you will develop

- + Health and safety
- + Customer service
- + Buildings
- + Energy efficiency
- + Materials
- + Alternative construction techniques
- + Radial and battered brickwork
- + Feature and reinforced brickwork
- + Fireplaces and chimneys
- + Masonry structures
- + Preparation of materials
- + Safe working
- + Working area

Behaviours you will develop

- + Positive and mature attitude
- + Quality focused
- + Effective communication
- + Self-motivated learner

Entry requirements

- + Initial assessments in Maths and English
- + Comprehensive skills scan

Maths and English

All learners on a Level 2 Apprenticeship will need provide evidence of a minimum Level 1 in Maths and English (or equivalent) prior to entering EPA Cateway.

If you do not have evidence of either Level 1 English or Maths (at least one is required), please speak to the Apprenticeship team for further guidance.

If you have a Level 1 in English or Maths, you will be required to achieve a minimum of Level 1 in all areas prior to Cateway. Once a Level 1 in English and Maths can be evidenced, then Apprentices are required to attend Level 2 Maths and/or English sessions.

How long will it last?

Typical duration: 24 months, plus 3 months for End Point Assessment (EPA)

How will it be assessed?

The end-point assessment will contain three components:

- + Knowledge test
- + Skills test
- + Oral questions
