# Who is this course aimed at?

#### What will you study?

Level 2 Functional Skills in Maths and English (exemptions apply).

#### **Entry requirements**

- + Comprehensive skills scan
- + Initial assessment in Maths and English

#### **Maths and English**

All learners on a Level 2 Apprenticeship will need provide evidence of a minimum Level 1 in Maths and English (or equivalent) prior to entering EPA Cateway.

If you do not have evidence of either Level 1 English or Maths (at least one is required), please speak to the Apprenticeship team for further guidance.

If you have a Level 1 in English or Maths, you will be required to achieve a minimum of Level 1 in all areas prior to Cateway. Once a Level 1 in English and Maths can be evidenced, then Apprentices are required to attend Level 2 Maths and/or English sessions.

#### How long will it last?

Typical duration: 24 months, plus 3 months for End Point Assessment (EPA).

#### How will it be assessed?

The end-point assessment will contain three components:

- + Knowledge test
- + Skills test
- + Oral questions
