Who is the course aimed at?

Managers that are responsible for everything from creating and delivering operational plans, managing projects, and leading and managing teams, to managing change, financial and resource management.

What will you study

- + Level 5 Apprenticeship Standard for Managers
- + Functional Skills in Maths And English Level 2 (exemptions apply)

Knowledge and skills you will develop

- + Project scope and planning

Entry requirements

- + 5 CCSEs at Crade C/4 or above
- + Comprehensive skills scan

Maths and English

All learners in a Level 5 Apprenticeship will need to provide evidence of a minimum Level 2 in Maths and English (or equivalent) prior to entering EPA Cateway.

You will need to provide evidence of at least one Level 2 in Maths or English prior to starting on the Apprenticeship. You will need to attend sessions to achieve all required Level 2 Maths or English to be able to successfully enter in to your EPA Gateway.

How long will it last?

Typical duration: 24 months, plus 5 months for End Point Assessment.

How will it be delivered?

Coaching towards End Point Assessment will take place in the workplace and classroom by a performance coach at an agreed location.

Maths and English will be delivered on a flexible basis.

20% off-the-job training during contracted hours.

How will it be assessed?

The Standard will be assessed through End Point Assessment once the apprentice, employer and assessor have agreed that the apprentice is EPA Cateway ready for:

- + Portfolio evidence
- + Professional discussion
- + Written project report with presentation and questions
