Entry requirements

Level 2 Maths equivalent to CCSE Grade C (4) or above as part of 5 CCSEs A-C (4 or above) or other comparable qualifications e.g. L2 & L3 accounting.

Maths and English

All learners in a Level 4 Apprenticeship will need to provide evidence of a minimum Level 2 in Maths and English (or equivalent) prior to entering EPA Cateway.

You will need to provide evidence of at least one Level 2 in Maths or English prior to starting on the Apprenticeship. You will need to attend sessions to achieve all required Level 2 Maths or English to be able to successfully enter in to your EPA Cateway.

How long will it last?

+ Typical duration: 18 months

How will it be delivered?

The professional diploma will be delivered on a weekly basis in college.

Portfolio build coaching towards End Point Assessment will be delivered in the workplace.

Maths and English will be delivered on a flexible basis.

20% off-the-job training during contracted hours.

How will it be assessed?

The AAT Diploma in Professional Accounting will be assessed by exams. The Standard will be assessed through End Point Assessment once the Apprentice, Employer and Assessor have agreed that the apprentice is EPA Cateway ready for:

- + Synoptic test
- + Portfolio
- + Reflective discussion
