### Maths and English

All learners in a Level 3 Apprenticeship will need to provide evidence of a minimum Level 2 in Maths and English (or equivalent) prior to entering EPA Cateway.

You will need to provide evidence of at least one Level 2 in Maths or English prior to starting on the Apprenticeship. You will need to attend sessions to achieve all required Level 2 Maths or English to be able to successfully enter in to your EPA Cateway.

### How long will it last?

15 months, plus 3 months for End Point Assessment

## How will it be delivered?

Both the Apprenticeship and the Coaching towards End Point Assessment will take place in the workplace and classroom by a performance coach at an agreed location.

Maths and English will be delivered on a flexible basis.

20% off-the-job training during contracted hours.

## How will it be assessed?

The Standard will be assessed through End Point Assessment once the Apprentice, Employer and Assessor have agreed that the apprentice is EPA
