

Bookkeeping Level 1 If you're new to bookkeeping this course will introduce the role of a bookkeeper as you learn simple techniques.

Introduction to Accounting Software Level 1

You will also study two optional units from the following four options; personal tax, business tax, external auditing and credit management and control.
